BE PREPARED

PLAN AHEAD: Evaluate the property and create a flood emergency response plan. Ensure your team knows how to access and activate it.

STAY UPDATED: Keep abreast of the latest in flood protection to ensure your measures are effective.

PROTECT YOUR SPACE: Use waterproof sealants and materials on non-return valves in drainage and wastewater systems.





GET READY

MOVE YOUR ITEMS

Move vehicles to higher ground |
Elevate heavy electronics on bricks |
Anchor fuel tanks to prevent floating |
Unplug electronics and power down
machinery | Store important paperwork,
tools and furniture on upper floors | Secure
or remove outdoor items that could float

SAFETY FIRST

Protect your home by turning off gas, electricity and
water at the mains | Don't forget to close flow valves
on gas and oil tanks | Fit a temporary toilet pan seal to
keep floodwaters at bay

SECURE YOUR PREMISES

Lock down those flood barriers on doors, windows and airbricks | Keep internal doors open or safely store them upstairs | If water rises above a metre, let it in to avoid structural damage | Seal external doors and low-level windows with silicone, then lock them tight for a watertight defence

HELP OTHERS

Let your neighbours know to take action | Pause incoming deliveries and ensure your shipments are sent out before the waters rise



SAFETY FIRST

Only authorised personnel should enter the work premises when it's safe | Ensure your team has a secure evacuation spot ready | Keep off-site staff informed about the situation | Avoid floodwater – it could be contaminated | Follow emergency services' guidance



Never walk or drive through water. Just six inches can sweep you off your feet and a foot can float a car! Hidden dangers like dislodged manhole covers may lurk beneath.
