Even careful drivers face challenges in bad weather. Where possible, it's best to avoid driving in heavy rain, floods, snow or ice. But if you're caught on the road, remember these tips to stay safe.

WET WEATHER & FLOODS

Avoid driving through water – just one foot can float a car. Hidden hazards like missing manhole covers may be present.

If your tyres lose contact with the road and glide on water, it's called aquaplaning. Ease off the accelerator and slow down to regain control.





TIPS TO STAY SAFE

Slow down and keep a safe distance from the car ahead

Test your brakes gently after driving through water

Park on high, stable ground whenever possible

SNOW & ICE

Winter driving is challenging with icy roads, rain and low sun. Stay safe to prevent accidents and keep your vehicle well maintained.

Driving an automatic? Check your manual for 'snow mode' to boost traction on slippery roads.
